### Qualifications & Experience


#### **Essential:**

- Bachelor of Education (General) or Special Education with relevant diploma or certification in special education.
- Experience in working with students with learning difficulties, autism, ADHD, or other special needs.
- Familiarity with international education settings, ideally within the IBDP framework.

#### **Preferred:**

- Experience teaching an IBDP subject in addition to learning support.
- Training in educational psychology, behavioural interventions, or literacy support programmes.
- Understanding of inclusive education methodologies and their application in diverse, multicultural environments.

# Key responsibilities



#### Key responsibilities:

- Provide individualised and small-group instruction to students with diverse learning needs, including dyslexia, language difficulties and subject-specific challenges.
- Conduct initial diagnostic assessments to identify learning needs and develop Individualised Education Plans (IEPs).
- Collaborate with classroom teachers to adapt teaching methods and create inclusive learning environments.
- Use assistive technologies and specialised learning tools to enhance student engagement and comprehension.
- Liaise with speech and language therapists, psychologists and other professionals to ensure holistic student support.
- Offer guidance and strategies to faculty on accommodating students with learning differences.
- Maintain accurate records of student progress and regularly communicate with faculty, students, and parents.
- Stay up-to-date with best practices in special education and inclusive learning strategies.
